

Dear Parishioners,

On this Third Sunday of Lent, we hear the Gospel of John's narrative of cleansing the Temple. The Temple in Jerusalem was the symbol of Jewish religion and the only center for Israel's common worship and sacrifices. King Solomon built the first Temple on Mount Moriah in 966 BC to replace the tabernacle that had been Israel's portable place of worship; I Kings 5 describes that Temple's solemn blessing of an area of 35 acres.

After 379 years, the Babylonians under Nebuchadnezzar destroyed the Temple in 587 BC and took all healthy Jews as slaves. On their return from 70 years of exile, the Jews rebuilt the Temple in 515 BC under the leadership of Zerubbabel, of the House of David. The rebuilt Temple was desecrated by Greek conqueror Antiochus IV Epiphanes in 167 BC and stripped of everything of value, but later, cleansed and restored by Judas Maccabaeus in 164 BC. Again it was plundered, first by Roman generals of Pompey in 63 BC, and then by Crassus in 54 BC. King Herod the Great began to renovate it in 20 BC. Jesus did his controversial cleansing of this Temple in the outer *Court of the Gentiles*, because Gentiles were allowed to enter in it for prayer to the Most High, if they wished to do so.

The holy season of Lent is the ideal time to clean out the Temple of our own hearts. Lent also teaches us that our Divine worship must be made vibrant by our active participation in the liturgy, with hearts cleansed by repentance and holy by allowing the Holy Spirit to control our hearts and lives. With a sincere and repentant heart, let us offer our prayer and worship to our loving God.

**The Catholic Church asks each member to preserve the penitential character of Lent. For this reason, Catholics, who have celebrated their 14th birthday, are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and each Friday of Lent; the age of fasting is from the completion of the 18th year to the beginning of the 60th year. Hence, in addition to abstaining from meat, one should fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, eating only one full meal. Smaller quantities of food may be taken at two other meals, but no food should be consumed at other times during those two days.
