

#### Dear Parishioners,


Today's Gospel passage is taken from the "Bread of Life Discourse" in John's Gospel. Here, Jesus makes the unique and bold claim: "I am the Bread of Life; whoever comes to Me will never hunger, and whoever believes in Me will never thirst." Jesus is offering the crowd Bread from Heaven—Bread that nourishes them for eternal life and the Bread available to people who have Faith in Jesus Christ. When Jesus instructed those who had sought after him for earthly food that they should be fed by the Bread of life, some accepted this teaching. But, others turned away disappointed because Jesus' challenge required a commitment that they were unwilling to make.

Jesus not only gives the Bread of Life, but Jesus is truly the Bread of Life. The Giver and the Gift are One and the same. As the Bread of Life from Heaven, Jesus claims that only He can satisfy man's spiritual hunger. While bodily food helps us to stay alive in this world, Spiritual Food sustains and develops our supernatural life which will last forever in Heaven.

Through God's infinite love, we are given, in the Blessed Eucharist, the very Author of the Gifts of Faith and Sanctifying Grace. Thus, the Eucharist is not a mere "symbol" of Jesus; rather, it is a Sacramental sign of Jesus' Real Bodily Presence in His glorified, scarred, risen Body. This Bread of Life—Who is Jesus Himself—gives mankind a new relationship with God, a relationship of trust, obedience and love.
