

## Dear Parishioners,

In today's gospel, a scribe asked Jesus, which is the first of all the commandments? Then Jesus summarizes the most important of the Mosaic Laws in one sentence. Jesus cites the first sentence of the Jewish Shema prayer: "Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God is Lord alone! Therefore, you shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength" (Dt 6:4). Then He adds its complementary law: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself" (Lv 19:18). Thus, Jesus says that true religion is loving God and loving our fellow human beings at the same time. It is by showing genuine, active love for our neighbors that we can demonstrate that we really love God.

So how do we love God and neighbor? We do so by keeping God's commandments and offering daily prayers of thanksgiving, praise, contrition for our failings, and petition. If I am going to love God with all my heart, soul, mind, and strength, then I am going to have to place His will ahead of mine, and ask Him for help when I have to say no to some things that I might want to do. We love our neighbor by helping, supporting, encouraging, forgiving, and praying for everyone, without discrimination based on color, race, gender, age, wealth, or social status. Let us take up this challenge.
