

Dear Parishioners,

In today's Gospel, Jesus reveals himself as the true "Bread of Life that came down from Heaven," to give life to the world. Jesus proclaims himself as the new and perfect manna, the Incarnate Son of God literally "come down from Heaven."

This means that through the Holy Eucharist, Jesus actually gives us a share of eternal life while we are still on earth. But some of Jesus' followers would turn away when he explained the source of his mysterious power and his heavenly origin.


