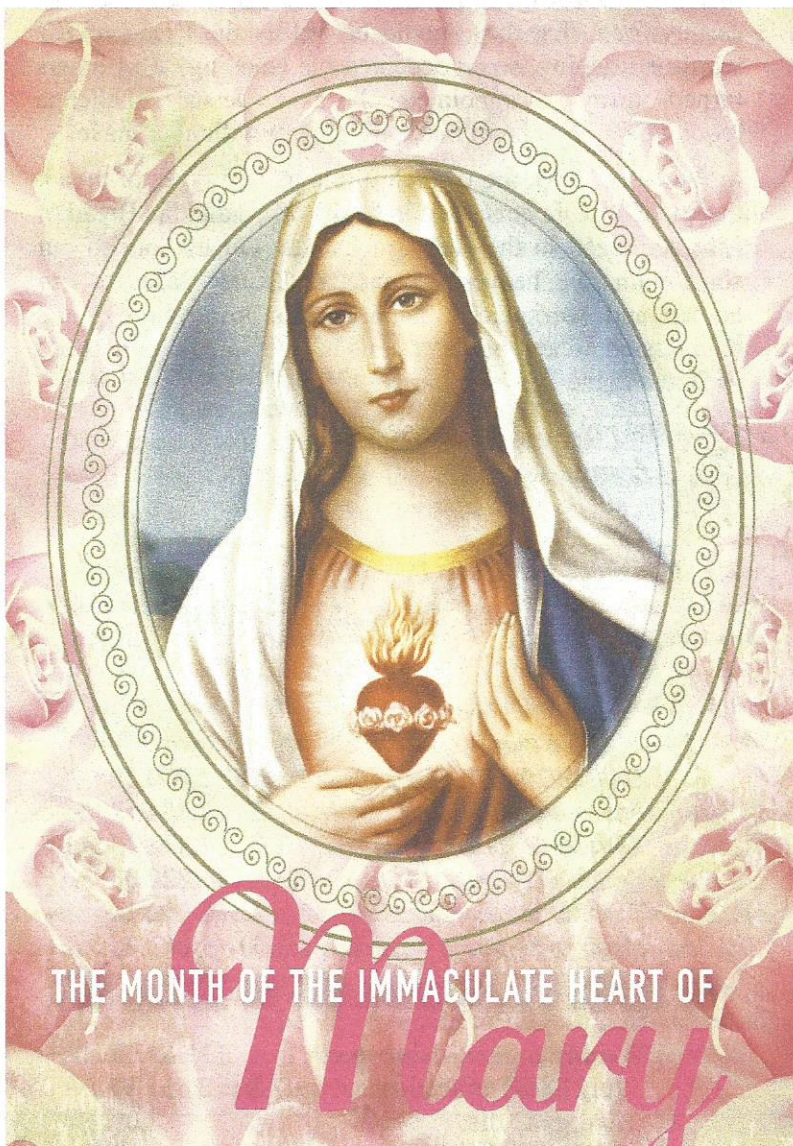

Dear Parishioners,

Today's Gospel passage is taken from the "Bread of Life Discourse" in John's Gospel. Here Jesus makes the unique and bold claim: "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst." Jesus is offering the crowd Bread from Heaven—Bread that nourishes them for eternal life; the Bread available to people who have faith in Jesus Christ.

When Jesus instructed those who had sought after him for earthly food, that they should be fed by the Bread of His word or teaching, some accepted his teaching. But others turned away disappointed, because Jesus' challenge required a commitment that they were unwilling to make.

In the Holy Mass, the Church offers us two types of bread: the Bread of Life contained in God's Word and the Bread of Life contained in the Holy Eucharist. Let us nourish our souls with this heavenly manna and carry Jesus to our homes and workplaces, radiating his love, mercy, and compassion all around us. Let us be nourished by the Word of God and the Holy Eucharist.

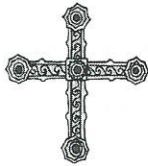

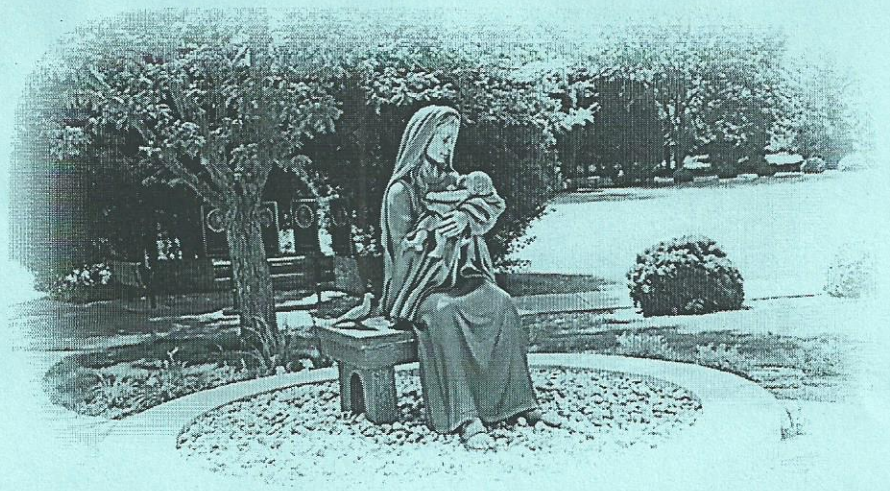
