

Dear Parishioners,

This year we are beginning the holy season of **Lent** on February 14 with the celebration of **Ash Wednesday**. On this day, we are blessed with ashes, reminding us that we are dust and to dust we will return. For the next 40 days, we are led into the desert of our own hearts to look within, face our sins, and ask for God's mercy. It is the season when we enter into Christ's dying and rising as we seek to purify, cleanse, and nourish our bodies, minds, and souls.

The way to the soul is through our body. That's why Lenten discipline has historically centered on the "Big Three" of fasting, almsgiving, and prayer. **Fasting** is not just a spiritual diet. By denying our bodies, our physical hunger reminds us of the hunger of our souls for God, our longing for a deeper relationship with Our Lord and neighbor.

<u>Almsgiving</u> teaches us to separate ourselves from material possessions. By freely giving our money and possessions, we learn to trust the Lord more deeply for our own daily needs.

Finally, an emphasis on <u>PRAYER</u> during Lent is a way to stir up our love and ardor by having a deepening conversation with the Almighty. Remember the light of God's love shines more brightly in the darkness of the recognition of our own sinfulness. So, the most important thing anyone can do for Lent is to "return to the Lord with your whole heart" (Joel 2:12).

The Catholic Church asks each member to preserve the penitential character of Lent. For this reason, Catholics, who have celebrated their 14th birthday, are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and each Friday of Lent; the age of fasting is from the completion of the 18th year to the beginning of the 60th year. Hence, in addition to abstaining from meat, one should fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, eating only one full meal. Smaller quantities of food may be taken at two other meals, but no food should be consumed at other times during those two days. United States Council of Catholic Bishops
