DEAR PARISHIONERS

On this First Sunday of Lent, we witness Luke's version of the temptation of Jesus. At Jesus' baptism, God declared him "beloved Son," and Luke begins today's gospel: "Filled with Holy Spirit" and led by the Spirit, Jesus went into the desert for forty days. The same Spirit allows Jesus to be tested, subjecting the divine Son to a completely human experience: temptation.

For Jesus' contemporaries, the wilderness served a dual purpose: there one might encounter temptation; there one might encounter God. As the story proceeds, we learn that Jesus is God's beloved Son who is completely faithful to enacting his Father's will. Jesus does not succumb to temptation because he recognizes and trusts that true life comes from God. Jesus does not seek power and prestige, but he is here to serve and give his life. He proclaims the kingdom of God and glorifies his heavenly Father.

We are God's sons and daughters by adoption. This holy season of Lent gives us an opportunity to grow in fidelity as a child of God. To do so, we need to withstand many the voices and inclinations that lure us away from being the person God calls us to be. Like the psalmist, let us rely on God who is with us. Let us ask Jesus to protect us from the many voices of temptation luring us away from God and His calling.

**The Catholic Church asks each member to preserve the penitential character of Lent. For this reason, Catholics, who have celebrated their 14th birthday, are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and each Friday of Lent; the age of fasting is from the completion of the 18th year to the beginning of the 60th year. Hence, in addition to abstaining from meat, one should fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, eating only one full meal. Smaller quantities of food may be taken at two other meals, but no food should be consumed at other times during those two days.





Using a cellophane bag to enclose the basket contents would be much appreciated. You can purchase these at the Dollar store. Thank you for your donation!




