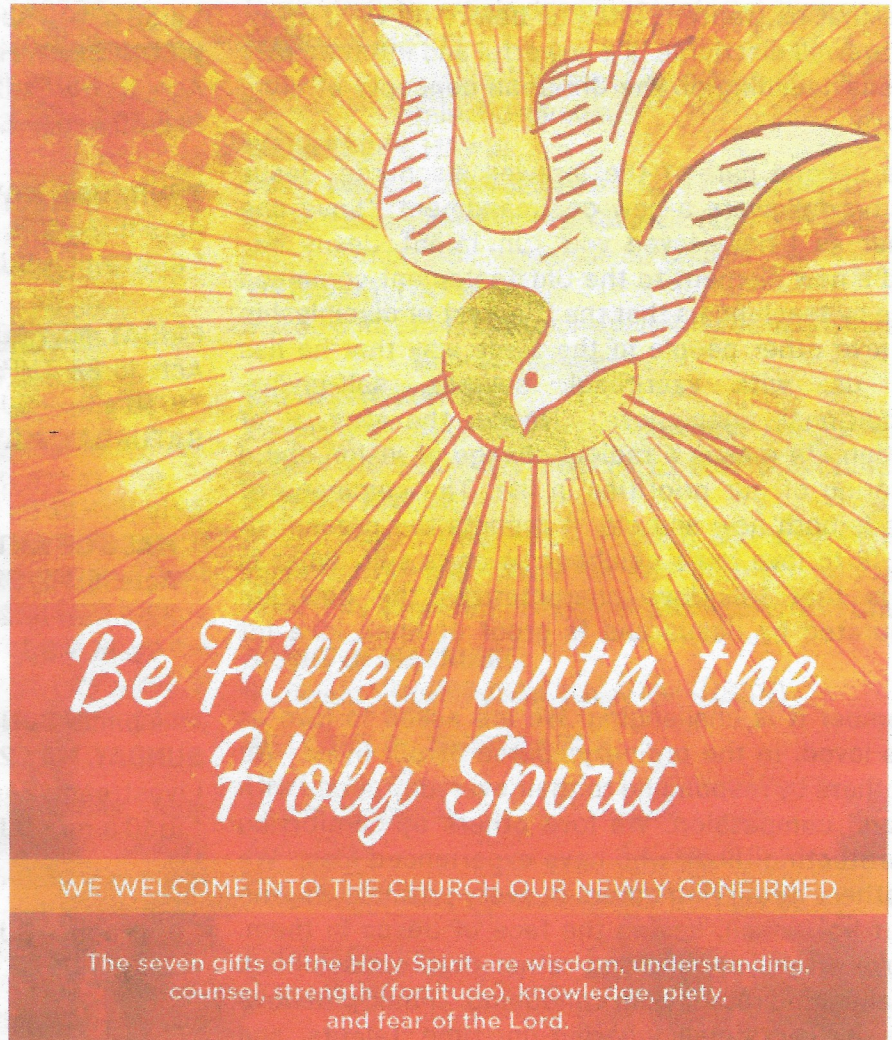

DEAR PARISHIONERS

Today's Gospel reading comes from Chapter 13 of St. John's Gospel known as "The Last Discourse," which took place at the Last Supper. In this chapter, Jesus has left urgent messages for his Apostles and for us – things that he wanted to tell us before he went away. This farewell discourse is a powerful and intimate part of Jesus' teaching on the Christian concepts of glory and love.

In the second part of the farewell discourse, Jesus gives his followers a new commandment: "Love one another as I have loved you" (Jn 13:35). Jesus has added a new element to the Old Testament command of love by teaching us that the true test of discipleship is to love other people in the same way that he has loved us, with sacrificial, selfless, self-giving, unconditional, agápe love. Hence, the renewal of Christian life means a radical change of vision and a reordering of our priorities in life. The command of Jesus is both new and old. It repeats the precept of Lv 19:18 to love one's neighbor as one's self. What is new is that this love characterizes the new life inaugurated by Jesus and is proof of one's love for God.

Remember it is challenging. We are asked to love as Jesus loved, in the ordinary course of our lives. We love others by responding to their everyday needs with love and compassion. We love others by comforting and protecting those who have experienced loss. We love others by serving others in every possible way, no matter how small, seeing the face of Jesus in them. We love others by forgiving rather than condemning, by challenging rather than condoning. Finally, we love others by sacrificially sharing our time, talents, and blessings with them. Let us love others in our daily life.
