## DEAR PARISHIONERS

Today, St. John Nepomuk and St. Joseph parishes are launching their Wave 1 participation in the **Love One Another Campaign**. God's guidance and unconditional love have helped us navigate recent challenges, and our parishes remain vibrant faith communities. Celebrating 126 years and 147 years respectively, St. John's Czech and St. Joseph's German roots grew into Catholic faith-filled generations, anchoring our northside Racine neighborhoods. We stand on their shoulders as we look to the future!

Through much prayer and planning, we have identified our parishes' greatest needs and initiatives to strengthen our mission and vision for years to come. Each parish has its own **Love One Another Campaign** goal and parish share. The parish share of the funds raised will be used to enhance, repair and maintain the church campus as well as expand evangelization, faith formation, and parish ministry work. Please know that 60% of funds raised supports our own parish needs.

The remaining 40% of the funds raised enables the Archdiocese of Milwaukee to provide necessary resources to expand and enhance critical Catholic ministries throughout southeastern Wisconsin's ten county area, such as Catholic Charities for the poor and those in need, the expansion of Saint Francis de Sales Seminary, and priests' retirement. The **Love One Another Campaign** covers extraordinary parish and archdiocesan needs not met through the Catholic Stewardship Appeal.

St. John Nepomuk Church's needs include buildings and grounds repair, \$113,000, and evangelization and ministry, \$10,235, totaling \$123,235. St. Joseph Church's needs are church campus enhancement, \$260,873, and evangelization and ministry, \$10,000, equaling \$270,873.

We are so grateful for those who have already contributed and now pray for others to answer God's call to Love One Another!
