# WHAT IS SCRIP?

SCRIP is another way to pay for your everyday purchases using gift cards in place of cash, checks, & credit cards. This program enables families to raise money for their non-profit organization.

Here is how it works. We are able to purchase the cards from the Great Lakes SCRIP Center at less than face value. You then purchase the cards from us at face value and the difference is an instant profit for St. John Nepomuk Parish. It's really that simple! You can exchange cash or checks for these cards at the SCRIP tables located at the side door of church after both masses every weekend.

We already raise \$3,000-\$4,000 a year from our SCRIP program with limited parishioner participation. This program would be so much more profitable for St. John's if every parishioner were to commit to using one or two of these cards each week for the things they already purchase.

We carry a variety of vendors on hand each week at the SCRIP tables, including, but not limited to: Piggly Wiggly, Pick n' Save, Festival Foods, Citgo, Speedway, Kwik Trip, Walgreens, Target, Walmart, Panera, Texas Roadhouse, Subway, Applebee's, Olive Garden, Buffalo Wild Wings, Menards, Home Depot, Best Buy, Amazon, Dairy Queen, etc. We also have VISA cards available with no activation fee, we carry them in \$50 denomination at the Scrip table, but can order \$100 and \$250. There are over 300 vendors that work with the SCRIP program, if you don't see what you are looking for, please contact Jackie or Ryan Morrow (262) 989-1746.

With Christmas right around the corner, please consider using SCRIP cards to purchase some of the gifts you already need to get, or use the cards as gifts themselves. If you don't see a particular vendor at the SCRIP table you can use the order form on the back of this sheet and drop it off at the SCRIP table after mass. Your order will be filled and ready for pick up the following weekend.
