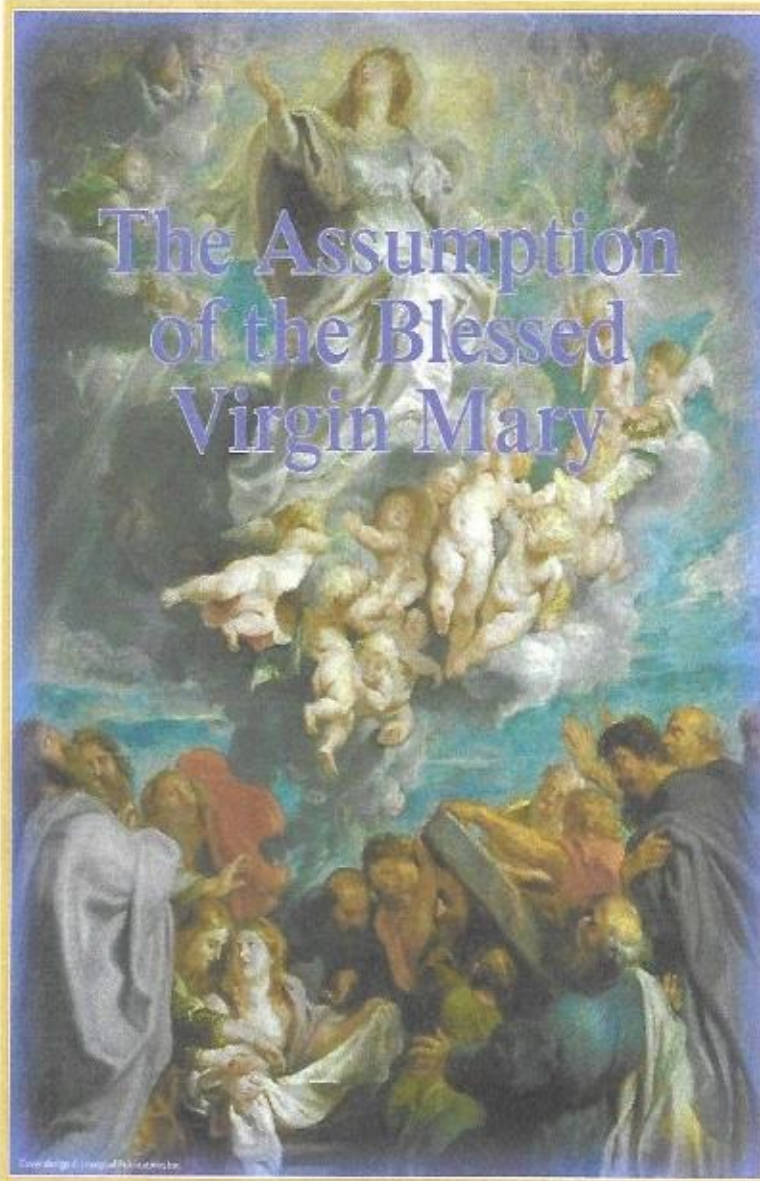

Dear Parishioners,

In the Gospel, Jesus challenges his disciples to trust the  
Father's promise to give them eternal happiness in His  
kingdom. But they are to be prepared at all times, because  
the Son of Man will come at an unexpected hour, either at  
the moment of their death or at the end of the world,  
whichever is earlier.

Using the master-thief parable, Jesus warns us to be on our  
guard, so that the thief (the devil) may not steal our treasure  
of divine grace or our relationship with God by his  
temptations. Jesus reminds us always to do the will of  
God by obeying commandment of love and offering humble  
and sacrificial service to others. "Waiting for Christ to  
return" means working for the coming of the Kingdom of  
God. This means doing God's will by rendering humble  
service to others, by combating poverty, by ending the  
hatred that divides us, by establishing peace among  
individuals and nations, by curbing the pride that causes us  
to become confrontational, and by building social structures  
that respect the dignity of individual humans.

of the Blessed Virgin Mary and a Holy Day of Obligation.  
We have 8 a.m. Mass at St. John and 6 p.m. Mass  
at St. Joseph. Let us seek the powerful intercession of

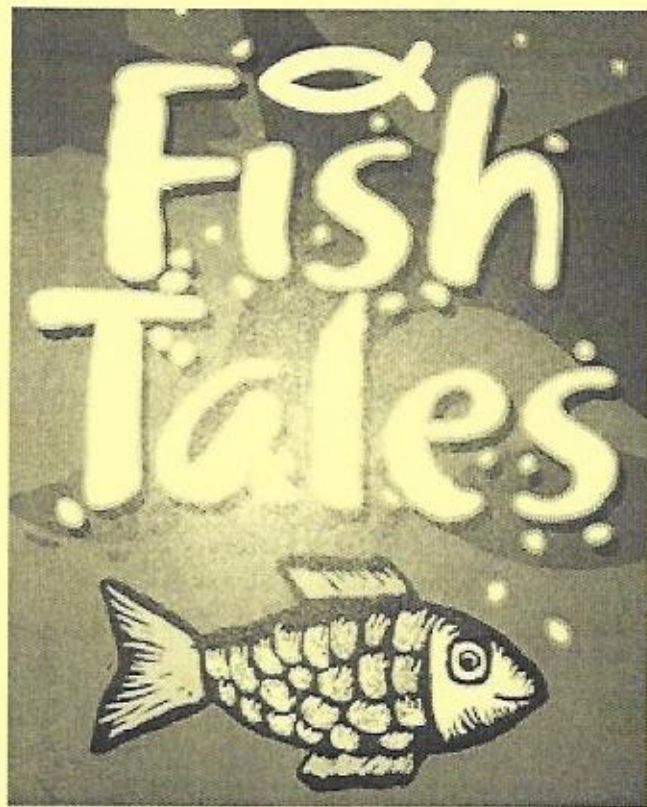
