Dear Parishioners,


Jesus' parable of the 'unforgiving servant' is found only in the Gospel of Matthew, where it is intended to be a moral exhortation for the Church on the need for forgiveness. Peter asked Jesus how often he ought to forgive his brother, and then answered his own question by suggesting that he should forgive seven times. It was the Rabbinic teaching that a man must forgive his brother three times.

It looks like Peter is willing to extend forgiveness up to seven times, and he expected to be warmly commended. Jesus' answer comes in the form of an idiom, "seventy times seven times," which means that, at all times and in all places, we are to embody God's forgiving grace.

Forgiveness involves more than absolution of guilt. It involves reconciliation – the mending of our past, now-fractured, relationships and the healing of our mutual brokenness. It involves intentional work to heal and be reconciled with another. God awakens in us the wholeness that invites us to share in His holiness. Healing, reconciliation, and forgiveness, acting together, sketch a way of life embodying an ever-deepening friendship with God and with one another. In this very difficult time, where our community is fractured with divisions, let us embody this message of Jesus.

We have reason to rejoice as we are moving forward in our progressive Catholic Comeback at this time of a pandemic. Please note that beginning with this week's 8:30 a.m. weekday Mass schedule, Wednesday (St. Joseph's) and Thursday (St. John's) are now public Masses. Wednesday Masses will have alternating halves of the St. Joseph School student body attending. Peace and joy,
