

DEAR PARISHIONERS

On this Divine Mercy Sunday, the Gospel vividly reminds us of how Jesus instituted the Sacrament of Reconciliation, a sacrament of Divine Mercy. The Risen Lord gave his apostles the power to forgive sins in his name with the words, "Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained" (Jn 20:19-23). This teaches us that Jesus uses the Church as the earthly means of continuing His mission. It also teaches us that the Church needs Jesus as its source of power and authority, and that it becomes Christ's true messenger only when it perfectly loves and obeys Him.

The Gospel's verses 24-29 present the fearless apostle St. Thomas in his uncompromising honesty, demanding a personal vision of, and physical contact with, the risen Jesus. Thomas had not been with the apostles when Jesus first appeared to them. As a result, he refused to believe. Later, he responds with his famous profession of Faith, "My Lord and my God" (Jn 20:28). The Gospel illustrates how Jesus shows Divine Mercy to the doubting apostle and emphasizes the importance of Faith.

The Church celebrates God's mercy in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Finding time for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is another good way to receive and give thanks for Divine Mercy. However, it is mainly through corporal and spiritual works of mercy that we practice mercy in our daily lives and become eligible for God's merciful judgment. Let us accept God's invitation to celebrate and practice mercy in our everyday Christian lives.
