



DEAR PARISHIONERS

In Matthew and Mark, Jesus asked certain questions about his identity. This incident took place at Caesarea Philippi, (presently called Banias), 25 miles northeast of the Sea of Galilee. Jesus asked a question in two parts. The first question: "What is the public opinion?" The apostles' answer was, "Some say John the Baptist, others Elijah, still others Jeremiah or one of the prophets."

The second question: "What is your personal opinion?" Peter, speaking for the other disciples, declared publicly: "You are the Christ (Messiah), the Son of the living God." Peter was the first apostle to recognize Jesus publicly as the Anointed One (also translated Messigh or Christ. Christ is the Greek word for the Hebrew word Messiah). Jesus confirmed Peter's insight as a special revelation from God and was quick to explain that he was not a political Messiah, but rather a Messiah who must suffer, die, and be raised to life again. The Catholic Church teaches that by giving Peter the "keys," he received primacy in the Church and the gift of infallibility in his official teaching on matters of Faith and morals. It was rightly understood from the beginning that those privileges given to Peter, necessary for the successful mission of the Church, were then given to his lawful successors, the Popes.

Jesus is the Son of God, and our personal Savior. Let us accept Jesus as our Lord and surrender our lives to Him.


