






DEAR PARISHIONERS

On this Second Sunday of Advent, we hear the voice of one crying out in the desert, prepare the way of the Lord. John the Baptist proclaimed a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. John preached that the appropriate behavior for those preparing "the way of the Lord" was to be baptized "as they confessed their sins."

He wanted the Jews to prepare their lives for the Messiah by eradicating the valleys of prejudice, leveling the mountains of pride, and straightening out their crooked paths of injustice and immorality. John recommended a baptism of repentance to the Jews who were familiar with ritual and symbolic washings. The most amazing thing about John's baptism was that, as a Jew, he was asking fellow Jews to submit to the baptism of repentance which only a Gentile was obliged to undergo.

We are invited by the Church to prepare for Christmas by repenting of our sins and renewing our lives so that Jesus may be reborn in us. Let us accept the challenge of John the Baptist to turn this Advent season into a real spiritual "homecoming" by making the necessary preparations for the fresh arrival of our Lord and Savior Jesus into our hearts and lives.







A Eucharistic Revival Initiative of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee New Years to Easter 2024

Come walk with us....

Invite 2-3 friends or family members on this adventure with you, or participate as an individual pilgrim walking with the disciples on the road to Emmaus (Luke 24:13-35).

Emmaus 90 participants "pilgrims" will receive:

- Daily prayer prompts for 90 days from New Years to Easter 2024,
- Challenges to grow in holiness,
- Short weekly formation videos by Livestream on Thursdays at 7:00 pm (or it's recorded for those who can't join us on Thursdays).
- A Pilgrim Guidebook journal to chart your course and track your progress,
- And a discussion guide to help encourage one another on the adventure.

How do I prepare?

Ask God to put 2-3 people on your heart to invite (up to 3 people or your family) to commit to journey through **Emmaus 90** together.

- Commit to at least 15 minutes of personal prayer with Scripture (an Emmaus 90 Journal with a daily scripture passage and prayer prompts will be provided)
- Commit to at least 1 of these personal prayer times per week being in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament (consider before/after Mass, local Eucharistic Adoration chapel, etc.).
- Commit to a daily Examen 5-15 minutes of reviewing your day with Jesus to thank him for all the blessings, notice & apologize for missed opportunities or sins, and ask for help to grow the next day (prompts provided in Emmaus 90 Journal)
- Commit to fast from meat on Fridays (or substitute an appropriate penance on Fridays until Lent) and offer it up for those farthest from and most in need of Jesus & his Church.
- Commit to meet weekly (in person or virtually) with your Emmaus 90 group to have a 60–90-minute Discipleship Conversation about:
 - o How are you?
 - How are you and God? (Or what's your relationship with God in your daily prayer with Scripture, Examen, and daily life been like for you this week?)
 - How are you doing with what we've been learning in Emmaus 90?
 - What did the Lord show you from what we learned last week?
 - Let's watch the 30-minute formation session together and discuss what stands out to us (livestreamed or the recording of the livestream)
 - o How can I pray for you?
 - Let's pray for each other right now. (pray together)

The Livestreamed formation sessions will include high quality formation on how to grow in relationship with Jesus in the Eucharist and be equipped to be a Eucharistic Missionary in their daily life. Formation sessions will be taught by local and national speakers.
