

DEAR PARISHIONERS

On this 30th Sunday, Matthew presents another question from a scholar of the law about the greatest commandment. This was a challenge because, in the Judaism of Jesus' day, there was a double tendency to expand the Mosaic Law into hundreds of rules and regulations and to condense the 613 precepts of the Torah into a single sentence or few sentences. The Pharisees themselves identified 613 commandments in the Torah (the first five books of the Bible): 248 positive ("Thou shalt....") and 365 negative ("Thou shalt not....")

Jesus' answer was very orthodox and very traditional. Its two parts represent a combination of Dt 6:5 and Lev 19:18. Jesus cited the first sentence of the Jewish Shema prayer: "Therefore, you shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength" (Dt 6:5). Then He added its complementary law: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself" (Lv 19:18). Finally, He declared that the "whole Law and the prophets" depended on the commands to love God "with all your heart, with all your soul and all your mind" and to love "your neighbor as yourself." Jesus combined the originally separate commandments and presented them as the essence of true religion. The uniqueness of Jesus' response consisted of his understanding that the two laws have equal value and so are of equal importance because they are interdependent.

Jesus underlines the principle that we are to love our neighbor as we love ourselves because as God's children we both bear God's image, and to honor God's image is to honor Him. Love for our neighbor should be a matter of deeds by which we share with others the unmerited love God'lavishes on us. How can I translate this greatest commandment into my life?
