

DEAR PARISHIONERS

In today's gospel, Jesus explains to Peter and the other apostles what the Messianic Mission and their responsive discipleship really meant. Although he had predicted his suffering and death three times, his disciples were still thinking in terms of a conquering Messiah, a warrior king. It was then that Jesus rebuked Peter so sternly, "Get behind me, Satan," in an attempt to nullify what was, in fact, a temptation of the evil one urging Him to shrink from doing the work for which He had come.

It was the same kind of rebuke Jesus had delivered to Satan in the wilderness. Patristic Fathers suggest that Jesus was saying to Peter that your place is behind me, not in front of me. It's your job to follow me in the way I choose, not to try to lead me in the way YOU would like me to go. Satan is then banished from Christ's presence, and Peter is again called to become Christ's follower.

After correcting Peter, Jesus declares three conditions of discipleship — to deny yourself, take up your cross and follow me. True disciples of Christ are truly compassionate, humble, patient, forgiving and loving. Do I sacrifice a part of my time, talents, and income for my parish and the missionary activities of the Church? Do I practice self-control over my thoughts, words, deeds, and use of mass media, and put loving restrictions on cell phone and Internet activities of my children? Do I train my children in my Faith, teaching them to ask for God's pardon for our sins and failures and to thank God for His blessings?

Here's a final reminder: Next weekend, the Mass schedule changes and Reconciliation is at SJ from 3-3:30 p.m.


