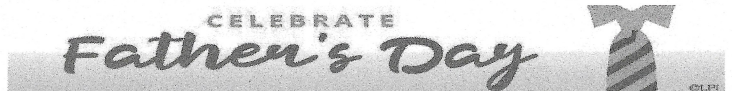

GRACE AND PEACE TO YOU, MY BROTHERS AND SISTERS,

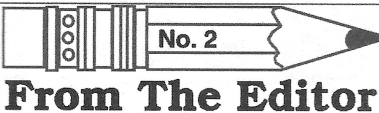
In the first reading, we hear a beautiful message from Jeremiah. Jeremiah speaks of the whispering of the people and their desire to harm him. They want him destroyed. But Jeremiah's response is to endure it with two excellent approaches: honesty and certainty in God's love for him. Jeremiah does not fear others and their whispering because God is with him as his witness and protector. God knows Jeremiah's heart, and that provides him with assurance. What a wonderful example for us to follow. Fear nothing. Be honest and trust in God's love. This is beautiful, but we also need to reflect on the other side, the "whispering side." Jeremiah's work as a prophet challenges the lives of many who were comfortable. He is bringing about God's vision for his people. Of course, that creates uncertainty and anxiety in people's hearts, which leads them to "whisper a plan to get rid of Jeremiah." But none of them can confront him. No one speaks clearly and freely to Jeremiah. How often we also fall into the temptation to whisper about others but are not willing to share our concerns with them. This attitude corrodes relationships and friendships. This attitude corrodes community and trust. This week, let us imitate Jeremiah in trusting God and being honest, and let us commit to always speaking the truth and sharing our concerns with those we love and care for.

In the Gospel, we also find Jesus teaching the disciples not to be afraid. Jesus repeats three times to his disciples, "Fear no one." Jesus wants his disciples to overcome fear so they can continue the mission. Fear paralyzes. Fear keeps people stuck. Fear doesn't let us move on. Fear makes us pessimists. When I reflect on the world and the things that happen around us, most of them happen because of fear. The Gospel message is clear. Fear no one. God loves us. And yet we have allowed social media and other communication tools to create this unnecessary fear in our hearts. If you were to name your fears right now, how many of those are probably unfounded and unsubstantiated, based on what we hear from others rather than on our own experience? The Lord encourages his disciples and followers to remain always trusting in God and his love. The Lord knows everything that is happening. Fear does not have a place in the life of the Christian.

This week, focus your prayer on trusting God and always be honest. Do not let whispering and gossip enter your heart. As Christians, we believe and trust that the Lord is always with us, so we should not fear. We are to embody hope as Christians. We are to embody God's love. We are to embody the certainty of a life everlasting in the Lord. Whispering, fear, and dishonesty go against all that. And we are disciples of the Lord who live faithfully in response to the invitation Christ makes to each one of us to bring about the reign of God in our lives.

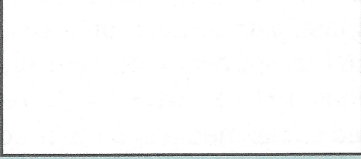

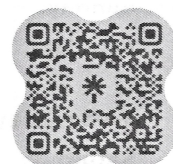


