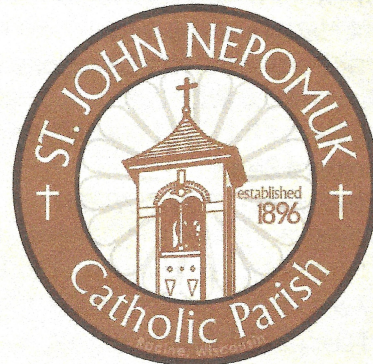
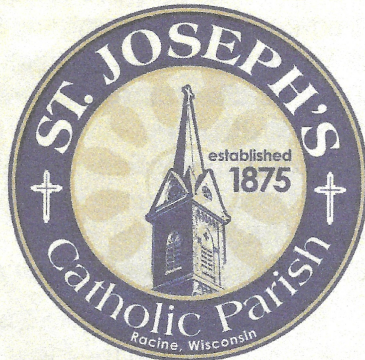

GRACE AND PEACE TO YOU, MY BROTHERS AND SISTERS,

This weekend, the Gospel reminds us that as followers of the Lord, we need to pick up our own cross and follow the Lord. If we are faithful to the Lord's mission to establish God's Kingdom on earth, we will face challenges and difficulties, even within our own families and among close friends. God's Kingdom is a challenging adventure for anyone not ready to give up their own desires and ideologies. Establishing God's Kingdom requires thinking like Christ, in terms of love, compassion, generosity, forgiveness, and self-giving; these values are paramount. Anyone who is not willing to walk that path will have a difficult time receiving the Lord's message.

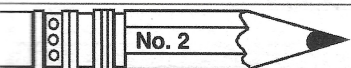
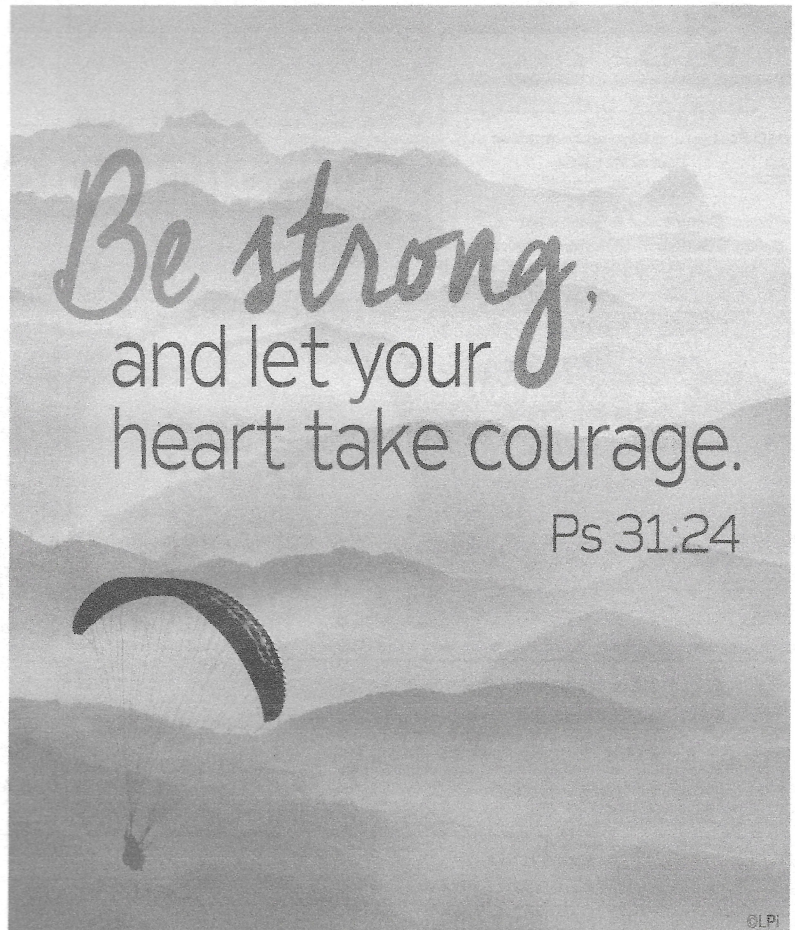
The other teaching in the Gospel is that Jesus challenges us, as disciples, to be intentional and make drastic decisions when it comes to putting the Lord first. Following the Lord cannot be accidental or simply a box-checking routine; it must be a daily choice to place our lives, our words, and our decisions before him. Intentionality helps us recognize where the Lord is inviting us to love more deeply, to forgive more freely, and to serve with greater generosity. When we live with this awareness, even the ordinary moments of our day become opportunities to carry the cross with faith and to make God's Kingdom visible in our homes, our parish, and our community.

This week, I invite you to choose one concrete cross to carry with Christ: forgive someone, reach out to a person in need, offer your time in service, or surrender to the Lord one attitude that keeps you from loving as he loves. Let that action be intentional and prayerful, so that our discipleship is not only something we believe, but something we live. In doing so, we will begin to understand that carrying the cross is not a burden we bear alone, but a path on which Christ forms us, strengthens us, and teaches us to make his Kingdom present wherever we are.

I want to express my gratitude to all those who have been working hard over the past few months to put together our Saints on the Lake Festival. It has been a great event to bring us together as one big Catholic Community in Racine. Thanks to the volunteers and everyone who made this event memorable for us and for the city of Racine.



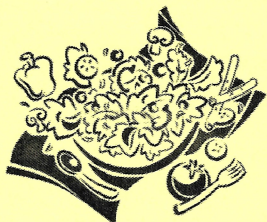
