## GRACE AND PEACE TO YOU, MY BROTHERS AND SISTERS,

The readings for this Second Sunday of Lent draw us deeply into our Lenten theme: a journey of **conversion**. This conversion is born not of fear, but of trust. Lent is the season in which God invites us, gently and persistently, to draw closer to him so that his grace may shape, prune, and strengthen our hearts.

In the Gospel of the Transfiguration, we hear that Jesus **"was transfigured before them"** and that his clothes became **"dazzling white"**. Peter, James, and John are overwhelmed by the glory of Christ revealed on the mountaintop. They fall in fear when the cloud of God's presence overshadows them. Yet in that moment of confusion and trembling, something beautiful happens: **"Jesus came down and touched them, saying, 'Rise, and do not be afraid.'"**


This is the heart of Lent. We come before the Lord not as perfect disciples, but as disciples who stumble, who misunderstand, who sometimes hide or hesitate out of fear. And still, the Lord comes close. He touches us. He calms our fears. He invites us to rise and continue walking with him. The Father's voice from the cloud speaks clearly, not just to Peter, James, and John, but to us today: **"This is my beloved Son. Listen to him."** To "listen" means to open our hearts to the word that calls us to change, to trust, and to surrender. Lent is the time when we let the Lord examine the vineyard of our hearts, and with his gentle and wise hand, prune what bears fruit. Jesus himself tells us that the Father **"takes away every branch in me that does not bear fruit, and every one that does he prunes so that it bears more fruit."**

God's pruning is never harsh. It is always done with love. He does not cut to wound, but to heal. He does not reveal our weaknesses to shame us, but to free us. And just as he prunes, he also strengthens. Abraham climbs his own mountain, Mount Moriah, trusting in the Lord with a faith that seems impossible. Yet at the moment of deepest surrender, God reveals that his desire is not sacrifice, but **faith, trust, and relationship**. Every Lent, God brings us to our own mountains, not to terrify us, but to open our hearts to deeper trust.

This season is not about proving our worth to God. It is about letting him transform us. He already knows our weaknesses, our hopes, and the hidden good within us. Conversion begins when we approach him just as we are, confident that his grace is enough. As we continue our Lenten journey, may we allow the Lord to remove what leads us away from him, to strengthen what is good, and to speak his healing word into the depths of our hearts. And may we hear the voice of the Father, clear, comforting, and life-giving again, calling to us: **"Listen to him."**



**For all those who take communion to someone outside of church, we are adopting a new policy starting this Lent:** Wearing a certified "CCER/Family of Eight" pouch entitles you to receive the Eucharist in your pyx in the communion line during Mass. If you are not wearing it, you may be asked to wait and get communion for your pyx from the deacon or priest after Mass. These cloth pouches with embroidered crosses indicate that you have completed the training for Visiting Eucharistic Ministers (VEM). If you have not been trained, please contact any deacon for a short training after Mass.
