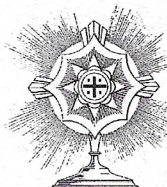

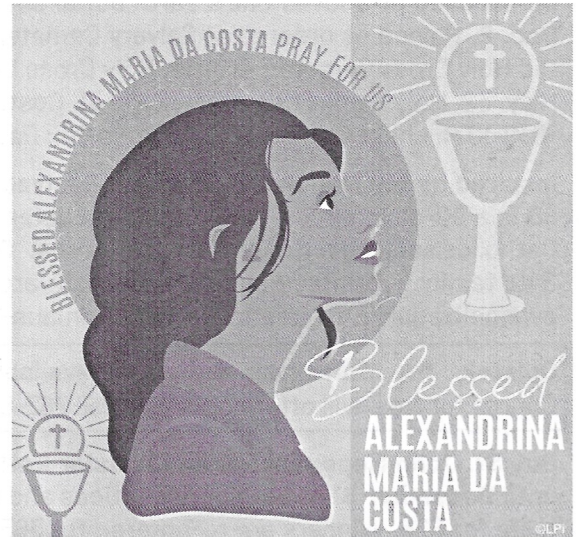
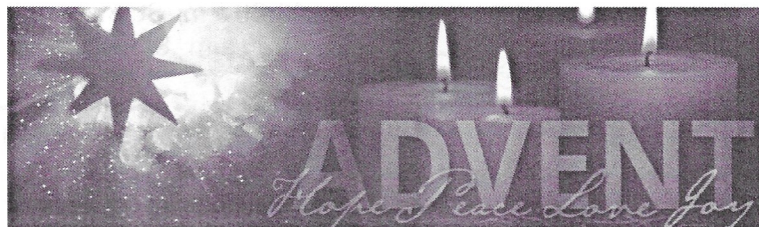

## GRACE AND PEACE TO YOU, MY BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN CHRIST

As we light the third candle on our Advent wreath, our journey towards Christmas continues with joyful anticipation. How is it going? Have you dedicated enough time to prayer, reading scripture, and acts of kindness? We are approaching Christmas at a very fast pace. I pray, the practices I shared with you at the beginning of this season are helping you to stay on task in this journey.

This Sunday, often called Gaudete Sunday, brings a message of hope and encouragement as we near the celebration of Christ's birth. Our theme, **"Following the Star,"** guides us to reflect on the scriptures and the light of Christ that illuminates our path. Our first reading from Zephaniah calls us to rejoice: "Shout aloud and sing for joy, daughter Zion! For the Lord has removed the judgment against you and has turned away your enemies." The prophet reminds us that the coming of the Lord brings joy and redemption. As we follow the star, we are invited to rejoice in the presence of God, who is in our midst. Take some intentional time this week to find God's presence in your midst. What is a source of joy for you? What are the things that bring joy to your life? List them and pray with them.

The second reading from Philippians echoes this sentiment: "Rejoice in the Lord always; again, I will say, rejoice. Let your gentleness be known to everyone. The Lord is near." Saint Paul encourages us to find joy in the nearness of Christ and to live out our faith with gentleness and peace. Challenge yourself this week to treat others gently. Let not harsh words come by your mouth. Share kindness and gentleness with others, even those who make you uncomfortable. Take that challenge this week.

Following the star means embracing the joy of the Lord, even in challenging times, and sharing that joy with others. In the Gospel reading from Luke, John the Baptist prepares the way for Jesus by calling people to repentance and transformation. He tells the crowd, "I baptize you with water; but one who is more powerful than I is coming... He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire." John points us to Christ, the true light who guides our steps and transforms our hearts.

As we follow the star, let us prepare ourselves to receive the light of Christ and allow it to shine through us. As we gather around the Table of the Lord this Sunday, let us continue to be inspired by the Magi who followed the star with faith and determination. As the Magi journey with confidence and trust the guidance of the star, let us journey in confidence, finding joy in every single moment of our lives as we journey to Christmas guided by the signs God brings to us. As John the Baptist prepared the way to the Lord, let us also prepare the way of the Lord to our hearts.
