DEAR PARISHIONERS

On Ash Wednesday we began the holy season of Lent. We are familiar with the name Lent. The name Lent is from the old English word Lencten meaning spring. Its more primitive ecclesiastical name for forty days is quadragessima in Latin.

The holy season of Lent is a time to prepare ourselves for the celebration of Jesus' death and Resurrection thru a renewal of Christian lives, which is like a spring cleaning. In the Gospel, we are told that Jesus faced and defeated the tempter at the end of his forty days of prayer, penance, and communion with the Father in the desert immediately following his baptism. It also tells us how Jesus started preaching his Messianic mission: The time is fulfilled; the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent. Believe in the Gospel.

The Church tries to achieve this goal by leading her children to a metanoia or true "repentance" and by a renewal of life through fasting, prayer, almsgiving, self-control, and practice of the corporal and spiritual works of mercy.

Let us use Lent to daily fight against the evil within us and around us by practicing self-control, relying on the power of prayer, and seeking the assistance and the daily anointing of the Holy Spirit.
