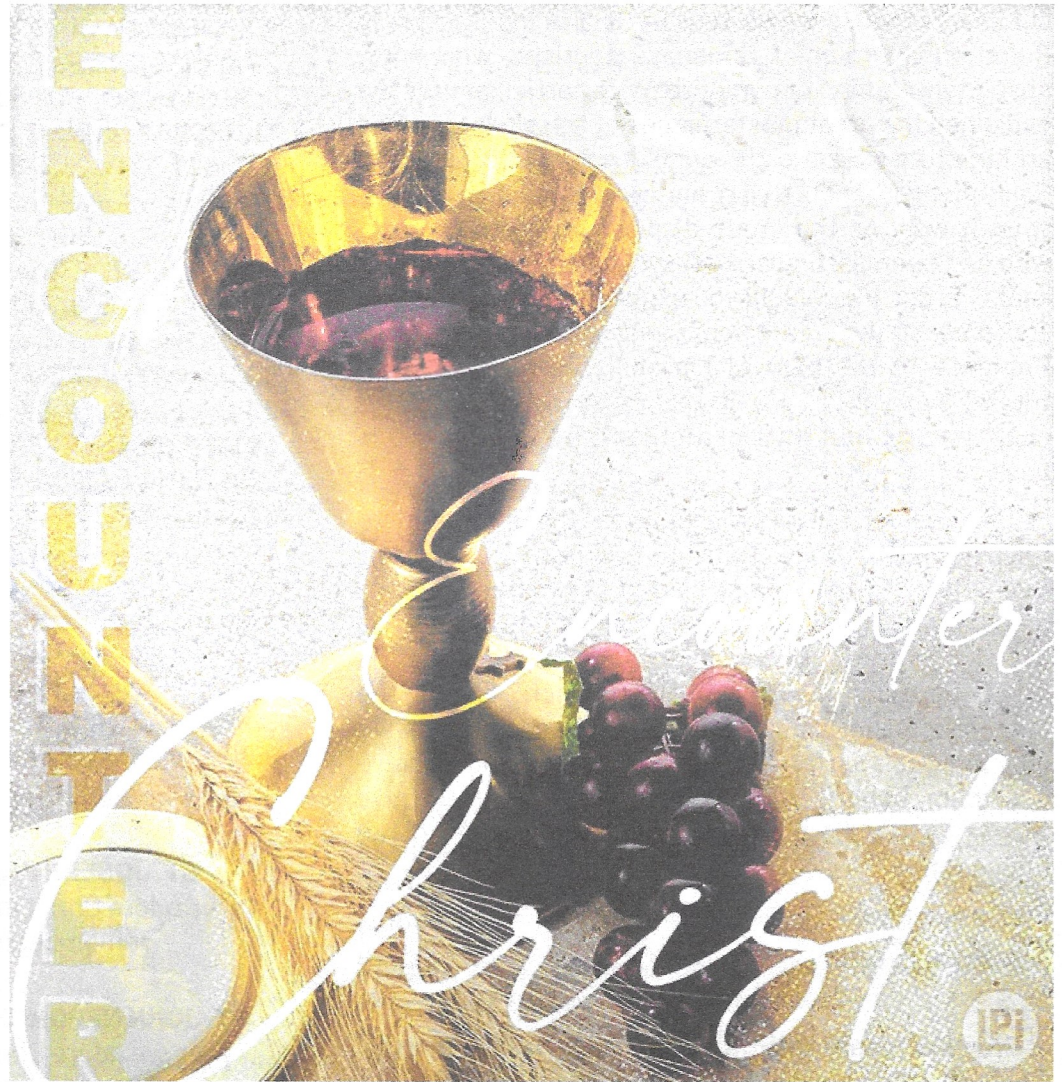

## DEAR PARISHIONERS

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, also known as Corpus Christi Sunday. Our former Archbishop and now Timothy Cardinal Dolan narrates an incident that took place in Rome in his book, *Priest for the Third Millennium*. A seminarian was giving a tour of St. Peter's Basilica in Rome to a group of Japanese tourists, who knew absolutely nothing of our Faith. With particular care, he explained the great masterpieces of art, sculpture, and architecture. He finally concluded at the Blessed Sacrament Chapel, trying his best to explain quickly what it was. As the group dispersed, an elderly man, who had been particularly attentive, stayed behind and said, "Pardon me. Would you explain again this 'Blessed Sacrament?'" Again the seminarian explained the Real Presence to the best of his ability, after which the tourist exclaimed, "Ah, if this is so, what is in this chapel is a greater work of art than anything else in this basilica."

In this year of Eucharistic Revival, it is important to realize what a great treasure we have in the Holy Eucharist. As the tourist said, it is greater than any piece of art. This is the most precious gift given to us by Jesus on Holy Thursday. This is also a great occasion for us to learn more about the importance and value of the Real Presence, so that we may appreciate the Sacrament better and receive maximum benefit from the Eucharist. Let us give thanks to our Lord for his abiding presence in the Eucharist.
