### DEAR PARISHIONERS

Today we celebrate the most complicated mysteries of all mysteries, the Most Holy Trinity. The mystery of the Holy Trinity, a doctrine enunciated by the ecumenical councils of Nicaea and Constantinople, is one of the fundamental doctrines of Christianity and the greatest mystery of our Faith, namely, that there are Three Divine Persons, sharing the same Divine nature in one God. We have the Father Who is the Creator, the Son Who is the Redeemer and the Holy Spirit Who is the Sanctifier and the Counselor - One God. The doctrine of Three Persons in one God, co-equal and co-eternal in Divinity yet distinct in Person, is not explicitly spelled out in the Bible. Even the very word "Trinity" is not found in the Bible. But, the doctrine of the Trinity underlies all major Christian feasts, including Christmas, the Epiphany, Good Friday, and Easter.

We are very familiar with the concept of Trinity because we are baptized, absolved of our sins and anointed in the name of the Blessed Trinity. Throughout the world, church bells ring three times a day, giving glory to the Triune God. We bless ourselves

with the Sign of the Cross, invoking the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and we conclude our prayers glorifying the Holy Trinity, saying "Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit."



Today's readings convey the fundamental mystery that the Triune God reaches out to people with love, seeking the deepest communion with them. Let us live in the awareness of the presence of the Triune God within us: The Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.


