GRACE AND PEACE TO YOU, MY BROTHERS AND SISTERS,

As we build on last weekend's scripture on the art of being present, today we take up the theme of prayer. This Sunday's readings draw us into the mystery and power of prayer. In the Gospel, the disciples ask Jesus, "**Lord, teach us to pray.**" Jesus responds with the Lord's Prayer and a parable about a persistent friend who knocks at midnight. The disciples understand that they need a way to pray and to bring their needs to God. Jesus gave them the beautiful prayer that we pray all the time. This week, I would say, be mindful every time you pray the Lord's Prayer.

In the first reading, Abraham intercedes for the people of Sodom, boldly pleading with God to spare the city for the sake of the righteous. This passage always fascinates me. Abraham takes a stand before God to intercede on behalf of others. He trusts his relationship with God and feels comfortable bringing this issue to God. These passages reveal that prayer is not just words; it is a relationship. It is a dialogue rooted in trust, love, and persistence. Jesus assures us that God is a loving Father who hears and responds to our prayers. Abraham shows us that prayer can be bold and compassionate. The friend at midnight reminds us that perseverance in prayer is an act of faith.

We all have the desire to improve our prayer life and cultivate a deeper, more profound prayer experience, a prayer life that allows us to journey in life, trusting God and following his will for us. As disciples, we can deepen our life of prayer in three ways this week, drawing from the scriptures:

Pray with boldness, like Abraham. Abraham's prayer is courageous and compassionate. He speaks to God as a friend, advocating for others. We are called to do the same, bringing the needs of our families, communities, and world before God with confidence. Perhaps you could each day this week, pray for someone in need. Speak to God from the heart, trusting in his mercy.

Be persistent like the friend at midnight. Jesus teaches that persistence in prayer is not bothersome; it is a faithful act. God welcomes our repeated prayers, not because he forgets, but because we grow in trust. This week, choose one intention and pray for it daily. Let your consistency be a sign of your faith.

Let the Lord's Prayer shape your life. The Our Father is more than a prayer; it is a way of life. It teaches us to seek God's will, forgive, and rely on his daily grace. This week, in the morning, pray the Lord's Prayer slowly, pausing after each phrase. Let it guide your thoughts and actions for the rest of your day.

This week, as you approach those three ways of deepening your prayer, ask the Lord to help, just as the disciples did, by asking, "**Lord, teach us to pray.**" As we continue to pray daily, we discover that prayer transforms not only our hearts but also the world.
