FASTING

Devotions, *Explained!*

Fasting was practiced by righteous men and women of the Old Testament and later by Christ himself. It remains an important part of the Christian devotional life today, being most strongly associated with the penitential season of Lent.

Prayer of Christian Life

Dear Jesus,
Help me to pray for and bless everyone I encounter, whether that be easy or hard. Help me to act in the mercy I have known through you. Help me to demonstrate generosity, as you have given so much to me.
Amen.

GRACE AND PEACE TO YOU, MY BROTHERS AND SISTERS

This weekend, the readings challenge us to radically reorient our perspective and align our actions with God's way rather than the world's way. The Gospel presents us with teachings that defy conventional wisdom and call us to live out a profound and transformative love.

In the Gospel, Jesus commands us to "love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you". These words are revolutionary and counter-cultural. In a world that often emphasizes retaliation, self-interest, and division, Jesus calls us to a higher standard of love and mercy. This radical love is not based on emotion or reciprocity but on a deliberate choice to reflect God's unconditional love.

Jesus further challenges us to give generously without expecting anything in return. "Give to everyone who asks you, and if anyone takes what belongs to you, do not demand it back". This teaching invites us to live with open hearts and hands, practicing a generosity that mirrors God's abundant grace. It calls us to trust in God's providence and to let go of the need for control and recompense. This relates to last Sunday's message of detachment from possessions to give from the blessings God bestows on us freely.

The familiar yet powerful teaching of the Golden Rule is also present: "Do to others as you would have them do to you". This principle encapsulates the essence of Christ's call to love and compassion. It challenges us to consider our actions' impact on others and treat them with the same dignity and respect that we desire for ourselves.

Jesus concludes this passage by urging us to imitate God's mercy: "Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful". This command encapsulates the radical reorientation of perspective that Jesus advocates. Instead of conforming to the world's standards of justice and retribution, we are called to embody the mercy and forgiveness that characterize God's nature. This is a challenging task, as it requires us to rise above our human inclinations and embrace a divine way of being.

These teachings are undoubtedly challenging for our lives today. Living out the Gospel's call to radical love and mercy can seem daunting in a society marked by polarization, conflict, and self-interest. Yet, precisely in this context, our witness to Christ's transformative love is most needed. Embodying these teachings, we become beacons of hope and instruments of God's peace.

I invite you to ponder the following in your heart this week: Reflect on areas where we harbor resentment or unforgiveness. Ask God for the grace to let go and to extend mercy. Look for opportunities to give freely, whether through acts of kindness, sharing resources, or offering our time and talents. Lift up in prayer those who have hurt or wronged us, asking God to bless and transform their hearts.

Come and have fun with fellow members of our Catholic Community. There will be great activities for the whole family, a piñata for the children, raffles, trivia games for adults, and music.
