

THE UNWORTHINESS OF THE ONE BEING CALLED

Greetings brothers and sisters in Christ!

I write to share some news with you. I have been called by our Archbishop to serve as a Parochial Administrator/ Pastor in a new parish beginning in June of this year. That means that I will be leaving the Catholic Community of Eight this summer. I know we have been walking together during this transition of the community of Eight for a short time but nevertheless I have felt blessed with the priest team, the wonderful staff and volunteers, and our beloved parishioners. I must confess I feel both sad for leaving and excited for my new assignment. But I also feel somehow unworthy of my call as a priest, which has allowed me to accompany you as your brother in Christ.

With that feeling of unworthiness in mind and the readings for this weekend (the call of Isaiah and Peter), it occurred to me to share a reflection on unworthiness. Unworthiness is that feeling of insufficiency or inadequacy, the feeling of lacking value, excellence or skills. I do believe this is a very common human experience, yet we should be careful about it. Certainly, in our relationship with God, unworthiness can come from a humble recognition of the Divine; but also, it could come from a false self-generated image of perfection. Unworthiness then becomes the petri dish where other feelings like guilt, remorse, anguish and even resentment can grow.


Now looking at the readings for this weekend, when Isaiah has a vision of the Lord in his might, he realizes how unworthy he is. But by the grace of God, he is "purified" and then sent as a prophet. In the Gospel, when Peter sees the miraculous catch of fish, he is overwhelmed and says, "Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man." But Jesus, still knowing who Peter is, and what he is going to do, wanted him to be his disciple. That is because to acknowledge one's sinfulness, does not equate with not being adequate for God's call.

Peter, who later is called Satan because he doesn't want Jesus to go to Jerusalem, is still called to share bread and wine. Also, the same Peter who denies Jesus three times and flees the crucifixion leaving Jesus alone, is still called to feed the lambs and become shepherd of the Church. Our sins, our mistakes will never make us undeserving of the call and love that comes from God.

I do feel somehow unworthy of my call to be a priest, but I know even within the frailty natural to humans, God has blessed me with a ministry of service for all. Know of my prayers for all of you and that I will always be grateful for the opportunity you have given me to serve the Lord with you.
