

GRACE AND PEACE TO YOU. MY BROTHERS AND SISTERS

This weekend, we celebrate the Word of God Sunday, an invitation from Pope Francis to pay close attention to the Word of God in the life of the Church. In our Family of Eight, we were honored to count on Dr. Dan Scholz, who shared his wisdom about the Gospel of Luke and Acts of the Apostles with us. The conference was part of Our Journey to Heaven initiative to **Learn** more about the Lord through Sacred Scripture.

In the Scriptures for the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time, we pay attention to two pivotal themes in our Christian journey: the Church as the Body of Christ, as expressed in Saint Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians, and the launch of Jesus' ministry in the Synagogue at Nazareth where he articulates his mission by reading the passage from the prophet Isaiah.


In the First letter to the Corinthians, Paul paints a beautiful picture of the Church as the Body of Christ. Each member, with their unique gifts and roles, is integral to the overall health and function of the body. Paul emphasizes that diversity within the community is a gift from God and that each person's contribution is vital. This concept transcends mere metaphor, urging us to appreciate and respect everyone's role within our faith communities. When one member suffers, all suffer; when one rejoices, all rejoice. Our unity and interconnectedness reflect the profound mystery of Christ's presence in our midst. I pray that we all work in the Catholic Church in Racine to achieve this noble spiritual goal.

In Luke, we witness the beginning of Jesus' public ministry. After reading from the scroll of Isaiah, Jesus boldly declares that he is the fulfillment of this prophecy. His mission is clear: to bring good news to the poor, proclaim liberty to captives, restore sight to the blind, set the oppressed free, and announce the year of the Lord's favor. This mission statement is not just a historical declaration but a living call to action for all believers. Jesus' mission sets a transformative agenda for our lives, challenging us to actively engage in social justice, compassion, and healing in our communities. This is Jesus' call to each one of us, and this is the voice we all must listen to. Today is an excellent moment for us to review the voices we hear and the actions we follow. I pray we are in sync with Jesus' voice and call for all of us.

In **Our Journey to Heaven**, we are called to **Live** as disciples of the Lord. This call means that we as believers must first embrace our unique gifts and the diversity among us, recognizing that every person is valuable and has something significant to contribute to the Body of Christ. This understanding fosters a spirit of collaboration, mutual support, and unity. We all practice compassion, actively seeking to understand and alleviate the suffering of those around us, standing against oppression and advocating for the marginalized and disenfranchised, and being mindful of the varied talents and gifts of the Holy Spirit within our community. I invite you to commit to serving one another and our broader communities in practical and meaningful ways. By embracing this call, we embody the teachings of Jesus in our daily lives as living witnesses to his love and grace.
