

THE SOLEMNITY OF SAINTS PETER AND PAUL

JUNE 29, 2025 | 05

GRACE AND PEACE TO YOU, MY BROTHERS AND SISTERS.

This weekend, we celebrate the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, two towering figures of early Christianity. Usually, nothing trumps the Sundays as the day of the Lord, but this year, the solemnity of these two great apostles falls on a Sunday, and we especially honor them today. This solemnity invites us to reflect on the life of these two great men. Though different in personality, mission, and background, both were chosen by Christ to build and spread his Church. Their lives and ministries reflect the diversity and unity of the Church's mission. It doesn't matter what our backgrounds and gifts are; the Lord always invites us to be his disciples and serve the mission of the Church. Pray to the intercession of these two great saints to help you find your mission in Christ's Church.

Peter, originally Simon, was a fisherman called by Jesus to be a disciple. In Matthew's Gospel, Jesus declares: "You are Peter, and on this rock, I will build my Church... I will give you the keys to the kingdom of heaven." Peter's role is foundational. He represents stability, leadership, and pastoral care. Despite his human weaknesses (denial of Christ and impulsiveness), Peter is restored and commissioned by the risen Lord. In the Gospel of John, Jesus commands Peter to feed his sheep and tend to them. In the First Reading, we see Peter miraculously freed from prison, a sign of divine protection. The Angel of the Lord came to him and helped him. The Lord is always ready to protect and keep his chosen ones.


Once a persecutor of Christians, Paul encountered the risen Christ on the road to Damascus. His transformation is a testament to the power of Grace. Deep down in his heart, Paul understood that he was not enough, but Christ is. He lived his life knowing that it was Christ who lived in him. In 2 Timothy, Paul reflects on his life: "I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith." Paul's mission was to the Gentiles. He was a charismatic preacher, theologian, and missionary, filled with the Holy Spirit. His letters form a significant part of the New Testament, and his journeys spread the Gospel across the Roman world. A zeal for the Lord took Paul to many places to proclaim him. How is our zeal for the Lord?

Though Peter and Paul had different missions (Peter to the Jews, Paul to the Gentiles), they shared a common love for Christ and a willingness to suffer for his name. Both were martyred in Rome, sealing their witness with their blood. The Gospel of Mathew reminds us that the Church is built on the confession of faith: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Peter and Paul proclaimed this truth in word and deed. How are we living this truth in word and deed?

What I find fascinating about these two apostles is their unique and different gifts to the Church. One brings stability, "Rock," and the other brings prophetic zeal. This solemnity reminds us that the Church needs both structure and spirit, tradition and mission, pastoral care and prophetic zeal. It is not one or the other; it is both. As we honor them, we are called to be living stones in the Church, proclaiming Christ with courage and love.
